1.2 Disaster Probability:

Flood: During rainy seasons, all the major rivers in the district carry gallons of water pose potential threat of flood. Things get worse as the flood devastates the crops in the affected area and is also a source of epidemics. The list of Circle-wise flood prone villages has been given in [ANNEXURE-II](#).

Cyclone: Nalbari district is highly vulnerable to cyclone and hail storm. Cyclones ordinarily bring in their trail heavy rains causing severe floods and saline inundation.

Fire Accidents: Fire accidents present a serious problem to the houses in Nalbari district. This is mostly due to the peculiar housing pattern adopted in the villages. These houses have generally walls with thatched roofs made out of timber, bamboo and straw. They spring up in clusters. Any occurrence of fire destroys houses and properties thereby causing serious damage to the affected people.

Earth Quake: Though Nalbari district has not experienced any major earthquake in recent past causing damage to lives or infrastructure, the possibility can never be ruled out as it can happen any time.

ANNEXURE-III

VULNERABILITY DUE TO FLOOD

[1] Embankments likely to be breached:

If the protecting embankments are breached or overtopped by rising waters in the rivers/ streams concerned; flash floods occur leaving the affected people very little time to escape.

The vulnerable stretches of the various embankments in Nalbari District have been identified by the Water Resources Department (*Nalbari Division*) as follows:

Nalbari W.R Sub-Division:-

(1) River *Pagaldia*:

The vulnerable reaches [*probable breach points*] on the *left bank* are

- (1) 3rd Km (*Pub Barsiral*); (2) 11th Km (*Katra*); (3) 13th Km (*Khatkatra*);
- (4) 15th Km (*Khanajan*); (5) 20th Km (*Dakhin Sandha*); (6) 23rd Km (*Namdonga*);
- (7) 24th Km (*Khejurtal*) and (8) 27th Km (*Raitkuchi*).

The vulnerable reaches [*probable breach points*] on the *right bank* are

- (1) 2nd Km (*Uttar Barsiral*); (2) 3.5th Km (*Niz Barsiral*); (3) 6th Km (*Keherua*);
- (4) 6.5th Km (*No. 3 Balitara*); (5) 8th Km (*Pub-Balisatra*); (6) 12th Km (*Farmchowk*);
- (7) 14th Km (*Moiradonga*); (8) 17th Km (*Ganesh Mandir*); (9) 26th Km (*Barmurikona*) and (10) 28th Km (*Arara*).

NB: Protection work are necessary at all the above mentioned reaches and will be acted upon as per situation / necessary.

(2) River *Nona*:

The vulnerable reaches [*where the river water overtopped during earlier floods*] on the *left bank* are

- (1) 5th Km to 8th Km [*Arora*]; (2) 9th Km to 10th Km [*Barajol (Noonapar)*] and
- (3) 11th Km to 16th Km [*Burburi*].

The vulnerable reaches [*where the river water overtopped during earlier floods*] on the *right bank* are

- (1) 6th Km to 8th Km; (2) 14th Km and (3) 16th.

NB: Recoupment and rising of the embankment in both banks at the above locations are necessary and will be acted upon as per necessity/situation at site.

(3) River *Mora-Pagladia*:

The vulnerable reaches [*probable breach points*] on the *left bank* are

- (1) 2nd Km (*Tengabari*); (2) 4th Km (*Suradi*); (3) 6th Km (*Gobradal*) and (4) 27th Km (*Bistupur*).

The vulnerable reaches [*probable breach points*] on the *right bank* are

- (1) 4th Km (*Paschim Suradi*) and (2) 8th Km (*Bistupur*)

The portion at 8th Km (*Bistupur*) on the *right bank*, remains breached. That breach portion of the embankment concerned near Bistupur village could not be taken up due to non approval of the scheme by the Revenue Authority.

NB: Restoration works of the other vulnerable stretches on both banks are in progress.

Mukalmua W.R. Sub- Division

(1) River *Brahmaputra*:

The vulnerable reaches [*probable breach points*] on the *south bank* are

- (1) 16th Km (*Mukalmua*); (2) 23rd Km (*Bartola*); (3) 25th Km (*Kaplabari*) and

NB: During last year's flood, the situation was very grave at *Hanapara* (3rd km on the right bank). Timely action was taken to meet the situation.

(3) River *Borolia*:

The vulnerable reaches on the *left bank* are *Chamukhaghat* (9.5th Km) and *Haripara* (13th Km). The *right bank* of this river falls in Kamrup District.

Along with the flood, erosion is another major hazard, as it results in reduction of land mass and eventual washing away of protecting embankments.

ANNEXURE-IV

RESOURCE ASSESSMENT FOR FLOOD MANAGEMENT

[1] **High Lands:**

A) **Embankments:**

To prevent the various rivers/ streams/ channels from overflowing on their sides, and thereby flooding the areas in their vicinity; embankments/ dykes have been constructed by the Water Resources Department. Such embankments/ dykes that have been built in the *Nalbari Division* river/ stream/ channel – wise are as follows:-

1. River Brahmaputra [<i>North Bank</i>]	= 48.50 Km.
2. River Pagaldia [<i>both banks</i>]	= 95.50 Km.
3. River Nona [<i>both banks</i>]	= 30.50 Km.
4. River Mora Pagaldia [<i>both banks</i>]	= 22.00 Km.
5. River Borolia [<i>both banks</i>]	= 17.10 Km.
6. Nadla Channel	= 14.70 Km.
7. Jaha Channel	= 2.41 Km.

These embankments were constructed couple of decades back; and therefore, they need raising and strengthening. Regular maintenance and repair during the floods are necessary. But, since the last couple of years, repairs and maintenance during flood through muster–roll labourers has been abolished.

[2] **Identification of High Land:**

A) **Embankments:**

Besides giving protection against floods, these embankments can also be used to shelter both Human Beings and Livestock during Flood. In fact, most of the people taking shelter in the embankments generally bring the thatched roofs of their submerged houses along with them.

B) **Raised Platforms:**

There is not even a single Hill dotting the Nalbari District after its vivisection on Revenue Circle, which could have been used as natural Flood Relief Shelter. The practical solution is to build artificial raised platforms for use during floods.

EARTHEN RAISED PLATFORMS: Under the aegis of both the NGO *Gramya Vikash Mancha* as well as the Community Development Blocks under Nalbari DRDA, several Earthen Raised Platforms (or *Vetis* in local parlance) have been prepared to provide high ground in low lying areas, which can be used not only to shelter livestock and cattle, but also to set up relief camps in case of extreme emergency. Such *Vetis* have been constructed in Nalbari District in the following places ~

ACTION AID-GVM – constructed: 1. Arangmow R/ Platform; 2. Nakheta R/ Platform; 3. Barsimaliya R/ Platform; 4. Sanekuchi R/ Platform; 5. Satama R/ Platform; 6. Bardhanara R/ Platform ~ [*all the above 6 numbers in Barbhag Revenue Circle*]; and 7. Burburi R/ Platform ~ [*in Ghograpar Revenue Circle*].

CD Blocks (under Nalbari DRDA) – constructed:

- D) Pathan Char R/ Platform; 2. Napara Pam R/ Platform; 3. Tupkar Char R/ Platform; 4. Paschim Said Ali Char R/ Platform; 5. No. 4 Barbala Char R/ Platform; 6. Kurihamari R/ Platform; 7. Natun Char R/ Platform; 8. Pub Kajia Char R/ Platform; 9. Kaltoli Char R/ Platform; 10. Belbari Char R/ Platform; 11. Kaure Khaiti R/ Platform; 12. Paschim Peradhara R/ Platform; 13. Other highland shelters would be identified at the GPDMC/ VDMC level, while preparing the GP-level/ Village-level Disaster Management Plans.

6. PWD Road from NH-52 (at Nathkuchi) to Tihu [fully *pucca*]
7. PWD Road from Arikuchi to Loharkatha (on Hajo-Mukalmua Road) *via* Bhawanipur & *via* Tarmatha *via* Bezkuchi [partly *pucca*].
8. PWD Road from Mukalmua to Nalbari-Chamata Road [fully *pucca*]
9. PWD Road from Nalbari to Dhamdhama *via* Moiradanga [partly *pucca*]
10. PWD Road from Karia (Bijali) to Ulabori [fully *pucca*].
11. PWD Road from Bogulsroad to Kalag [partly *pucca*].
NB: In case of high floods, portion from Sonkuriha to Kalag may get submerged.

The roads are essential for maintaining road communication within the District; and ensuring smooth distribution of Relief; during the time of Floods.

- **Relief Camps:** During the time of flood, the following Relief Camps have been planned.

Each Relief Camp would be under the overall charge of a *Camp-Incharge*, who would be appointed by the Circle Officer (Barbhag) at the time of opening of the Camp. In case of a school being used as Relief Camp, the *Camp-Incharge* would invariably be the headmaster or any local teacher of the school concerned; so as to ensure that the school properties are not damaged/ destroyed by the camp-inmates. In all other cases, the *Camp-Incharge* would preferably be a Govt. servant, in order to have proper accountability of the Camp Administration concerned.
